### Better information and communication

- More transparency towards the citizens
- Expand the services offered by the DippApp
- Simplification of municipal services through digitalization

### More participation

- An active children and youth council
- More citizen participation when it comes to new projects or the redevelopment of the heart of our villages
- Increased involvement of the consultative commissions in the decisions of the municipal council

- Creation of a platform where citizens can share their opinions and make suggestions

### A vibrant community

- Creation of new meeting places and opportunities for citizens
- Strengthening the community by introducing a local market, organising events such as brunches, common lunches, play afternoons, excursions and hikes, ...
- A café or brasserie in each village

## SUSTAINABLE A BETTER QUALITY OF LIFE FOR ALL

### Access to housing for all

- Creation of housing adapted to the elderly and people with special needs
- Creation of new affordable housing and promoting new living concepts (Tiny Houses, cohabitation, ...)
- A useful extension of the PAG and an adaptation of the building regulations to avoid unnecessary obstacles and costs

### Preserving nature and biodiversity

- Green spaces around the houses instead of gravel or concrete
- Flower meadows, late mowing, abandonment of pesticides
- Planting new trees (e.g. for every newborn baby in the community)
- Reducing the use of salt for snow removal in winter

### Better mobility concepts

- Introduction of 30 km/hour zones in the heart of our villages
- Narrowing of roads at the entrance to our villages
- Shared space in the central squares of our villages
- Increasing the attractiveness of public transport
- Increasing parking lots around the station and bus stops
- Limiting parking time near public and cultural institutions (municipality, cultural centres)
- Dedicated parking lots for vans and utility vehicles

### **Safe on the road**

- More pedestrian and cycle routes to connect our villages and neighbourhoods
- Better protection from traffic for our pedestrians and cyclists
- Pedibus for Sprinkange and Schouweiler
- More police controls on the way to school
- Better illumination of our pedestrian crossings
- More safety for our children on their way to school, on foot or by bike
- Intelligent street lighting to avoid a complete darkness from 1 a.m. onwards

### **Support in case of natural disasters**

- Improved flood protection: creation of more reservoirs and retention areas, dams, establishment of early warning systems
- Financial support for preventive measures
- Support for affected victims

### **Supporting good health and well-being**

- improved offer of courses to strengthen the mental and physical health of our citizens
- A health centre with various medical services

### **Efficient use of resources and food**

- Anti-waste dispenser/fridges
- Ensuring a good quality of drinking water and a sustainable consumption of this resource
- Promoting Repair-café
- Supporting circular economy and sharing economy initiatives (e.g. tools and garden tools that can be shared)

### **Local Business support**

- More visibility for our local businesses and the various employment opportunities they provide
- Attracting more companies and businesses that meet the daily needs of our citizens
- Attracting and supporting social economy actors for a sustainable development

### **Responsible management of finances**

- Responsible management of municipal finances
- Investing in projects for the common good and safety
- No unnecessary expenses

### **A strong association life**

- Responding to the needs of our associations by providing quality equipment (e.g. mobile dishwasher) and ensuring adequate infrastructures
- Reviewing the criteria for the allocation of subsidies to local associations and clubs
- Recognition of voluntary work

### **Services designed for all**

- More capacity for our elderly in the retirement homes of neighbouring municipalities
- Support with administrative and digital procedures
- Support for housework for the elderly or people with special needs (gardening help, snow clearing, etc.)

### **Different cultures, different languages, different needs**

- Multilingual information
- Offering language cafés to foster multilingual exchanges
- Cooking classes to discover new cultures and traditions

### **Everyone can be of help**

- A neighbourhood application to promote solidarity among our citizens
- Encouraging intergenerational support: young people can share their digital skills with our elderly (digitalization, use of mobile phones, etc.) whilst the old generations might also want to share their experience with the upcoming generations (homework support)
